

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL HEARING TO SET THE TAX LEVY
BOARD OF EDUCATION
HOMER COMMUNITY SCHOOL
September 11, 2017

A hearing of the Board of Education of Homer Community School was convened in open and public session on Monday, September 11, 2017 at 8:08 p.m. in the Library at the Homer Community School, Homer, Nebraska. The following board members were present or absent:

Notice of the hearing was given in advance by publication and/or posting in accordance with the Board approved method for giving notice of meetings. Notice of this hearing was given to all members of the Board of Education. The Secretary of the Board maintains a list of the news media requesting notification of meetings and advance notification to the listed media of the time and place of the meeting and the subjects to be discussed at this meeting was provided. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the publicized notice and a current copy of the Agenda was maintained as stated in the publicized notice. All proceedings of the Board of Education, except as may be hereinafter noted, were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

I. The meeting was duly called to order and notification of the Open Meeting Law is posted in the Library.

II. All board members are present except Murphy.

Motion was made by Reis and seconded by Vanschoiack to approve the absence of Member Murphy from the meeting. On roll call vote, the board voted as follows:

IV. Superintendent Cruickshank informed the board that about 95.5% of the tax request is actually received each fiscal year. There were no changes to the Tax Levy Request and no public comment.

V. Motion was made by Vanschoiack and seconded by Reis to adjourn the meeting at 8:13 p.m. on September 11, 2017. On roll call the board voted as follows:
